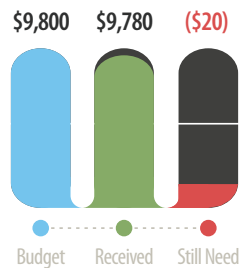
Women’s Ministires is planning a Ladies’ Pool Party at The White’s (2830 Kadota St.) on Sunday, July 20 1-3 pm.

Life Line Screening at Simi Church on Wednesday, July 16, offering safe, non-invasive preventive health screenings. Please refer to the flyer for more info.

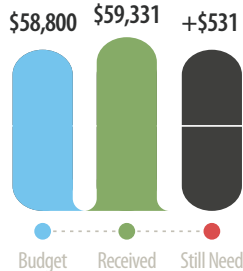

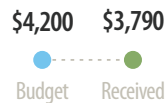
Church Budget JUN
