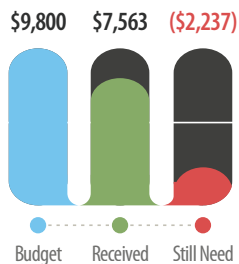

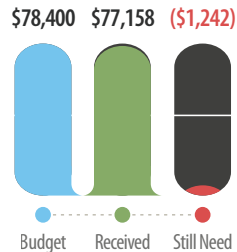

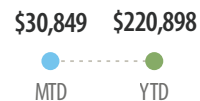
Church Budget AUG



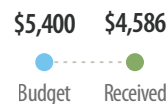
Church Budget YTD
